Personal Equipment

Required

- Jamboree duffel bag*
- Jamboree day pack*
- Clothing (see Clothing List)
- Travel cot (Go-Kot or equivalent) or foam pad
- Sleeping bag in a compression stuff sack
- Small pillow
- Towels (2)
- Metal mirror
- Soap in a plastic soap container
- Shampoo
- Deodorant
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Comb or brush
- Shaving gear (if needed)
- Insect repellent (lotion or pump spray)
- Sunscreen (SPF 15 or greater)
- Chapstick
- Laundry bag (cloth or nylon)
- Small flashlight with extra batteries
- Prescription medications
- Pen and pencil
- Small notebook or notepad
- Envelopes
- Sewing kit
- Plastic clothes hangers (3)
- Clothespins (8)
- Bandana
- Hand sanitizer
- Kleenex (travel pack)
- Neck wallet
- Passport
- Traveler's checks or debit card

- Receipt for traveler's checks (kept separate from the checks)
- Water bottle (32 oz. size)
- Cup with a handle
- Eating kit (knife, fork, spoon, plate, and bowl)
- Mesh dunk bag (sized to fit eating kit)
- Heavy duty 30 gallon plastic trash bags (6)
- One gallon Ziploc bags (6)

Recommended

- Sunglasses
- Watch
- Lightweight collapsible umbrella
- Camera and accessories
- Reading materials
- Board games (travel versions only)
- Bible, Testament, or prayer book (according to faith)
- International phone card
- Patches for trading
- Friendship gifts
- Name and address cards for exchanging with other Scouts

Do Not Bring

- Merit badge sash
- OA sash
- Any aerosol products
- Matches or lighters
- Laser pointers
- Anything that will not fit into your duffel bag or day pack

Clothing List

Official Jamboree Uniform

- 2 short-sleeve Scout shirts with the following badges and insignia sewn on in the correct locations:
 - 2007 World Jamboree patch*
 - BSA World Jamboree contingent patch*
 - Jamboree shoulder patch*
 - Troop 202/203 numeral*
 - Badge of office (if a Jamboree leader)*
 - Jamboree patrol emblem*
 - Badge of rank
 - U.S. flag emblem
 - World Jamboree Order of the Arrow pocket flap (if a member)
 - Interpreter strip (if earned)
 - World Jamboree nameplate*
 - World Crest emblem
 - Red shoulder loops
- 3 BSA "Switchback" pants or 3 Scout shorts
- 4 pairs of Scout socks
- 1 Scout leather or web belt (not needed with "Switchback" pants)
- 1 Troop 202/203 cap* (issued at the airport)
- 1 neckerchief slide
- 1 World Jamboree neckerchief* (issued at the airport)

Please note:

- **All personal equipment and clothing must fit into your duffel bag and day pack.**
- **Label all items with your name and Jamboree troop number.**
- **Do not bring any clothing items other than those on the list. (You will not have an opportunity to wear anything else.)**

Activity Uniform

- 2 Troop 202/203 Jamboree T-shirts*
- 2 Scout T-shirts
- 4 pairs of hiking socks (Thorlo, SmartWool, or equivalent)

Other Clothing Items

- 1 rain jacket & rain pants (recommended) or the Jamboree poncho*
- 8 sets of underwear
- 2 sets of sleepwear
- 1 swimming shorts
- 1 pair of old jeans, shirt, and socks for service project
- 1 fleece jacket or for cool weather wear
- 1 Scout shirt with regular insignia for trading at the end of the Jamboree

Shoes

- 1 pair of waterproof hiking shoes
- 1 pair of athletic shoes
- 1 pair of Crocs or similar light-weight shoes for campsite wear (no open-toed sandals)
