Greetings Jamboree Scout!

In a little over eight months, we will be departing for the World Jamboree and the experience of a lifetime! Your adult World Jamboree leaders recently spent a weekend in Atlanta, Georgia planning for the Jamboree, and everything is looking great.

Below is some important information and reminders about Jamboree – please read everything carefully, and share it all with your parents.

**World Jamboree Troop Rosters** – As you know, Circle Ten is sending two troops to the Jamboree. Enclosed are rosters for both troops. Also enclosed is a sheet of paper with your information. Please check it closely, and notify Don Wendell of any changes. If there are no changes, please notify him of that as well. **Also, please be sure that we have an e-mail address that both you and your parents can access.** E-mail will be our primary means of communication.

**Shakedown Campout** – A mandatory shakedown campout will be held from **Friday, April 27 at 6:00 pm until Sunday, April 29 at 12:00 noon**. If you haven't already done so, please put these dates on your family calendar. The campout will be held at a Circle Ten Council camp. More information will be provided later.

**Passport** – If you do not have a passport, please get one now! You will need to bring your passport to the shakedown campout. Also, if you already have a passport, please check the expiration date – it must be valid for six months beyond our Jamboree departure date.

**Jamboree Fee Payments** – By now, you should have paid \$2225 toward the Jamboree, with another \$575 due November 30. Please keep your payments up-to-date.

**Troop Meeting** – We will have a Jamboree troop meeting in late January or early February. As soon as the date and location are set, we will notify you by e-mail.
